

LEAFLET HAIR TRANSPLANTATION OF EYEBROWS

What will be done?

Healthy hair roots from the back of the head are transplanted to areas of sparse hair or bald spots of the eyebrows.

The problem of this treatment is that the hair grows and eyebrows need to be regularly cut. At the beginning, eyebrows will be bushy. After 6 to 8 months, the hair will start to grow in the correct direction.

Planning of the operation

As a first step, expectations and wishes of patients will be determined and discussed. To achieve good results, at least 2 sessions with intervals of roughly 6 months will be necessary.

Operation

This is an outpatient procedure in sedation and local anesthesia. It will take place in our practice-owned operating theatre. A skin strip (1 cm wide) with healthy hair roots will be extracted from the hair crown of the back of the head. The edges of the wound will be sutured with cosmetic stitches.

The hair strip will be divided into individual hairs (follicular units or grafts) under the microscope. Then they will be transplanted to the desired areas.

Follow-up treatment

The day after the operation, a medical check-up will take place in the doctor's office. Stitches will be removed after 10 to 14 days.

What needs to be taken into account?

- Do not expose to sun for 2 to 4 months (use loose head covering).
- Do not do any exercise or swim during 2 weeks.
